Sep 17 | Rhodes, Greece | 8:00am-10:00pm First on your of Virgin Mary, where Mary is said to have spent her last agenda should be the Rhodes waterfront where once days.

(B,L,D) stood the Colossus of Rhodes, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Just a short ride away, the medieval town of Lindos features houses stacked like giant Saint Paul's Bay.
