July 9 - Us departure

Today board your overnight flight to Reykjavik, the capital of Iceland.

July 10 - Reykjavik | viking Museum | City tour

Upon arrival, you will be met by your local guide at the airport. Your first Iceland experience will be the Viking World Museum. A snack and a refreshing drink is included at the museum's cafeteria before you start your panoramic city tour of Reykjavik. Early this afternoon you will check into your hotel. Tonight a welcome to Iceland dinner is included.

Overnight: Reykjavik (B,D)

July 11 - Langjokull - Into the Glacier experience

Today you travel to Husafell, home of Iceland's second- largest glacier. Overnight: Husafell area

July 12 - The mountains of the Northwest | Godafoss This morning board your motorcoach and travel to its abundance of Icelandic horses. This afternoon in the hotel's dining room. stop at Goðafoss Waterfall, known locally as the Waterfall of the Gods for its godlike beauty and one of the most spectacular falls in Iceland. Later arrive in the Mytvatn area and check into your hotel for the next two nights. Dinner tonight is included.

Overnight: Myvatn area (B,L,D)

July 13 - Pseudo Craters, Lake Myvatn | Natural Baths After breakfast your first stop this morning is at Myt-

vatn Nature Baths, also known as the Blue Lagoon of the North. Start this natural experience with a relaxing dip in clouds of steam rising from a fissure deep in the earth's surface, followed by a swim in a pool of geothermal water that is drawn from depths of up to 6000 ft. After an included lunch you will explore the Lake Mytvatn area, located in the heart of north-east Iceland and about 65 miles south of the Arctic Circle. The Lake and its surroundings are some of Europe's greatest natural treasures. Set in a dramatic landscape, the shallow lake is dominated by volcanic landforms such as pseudo-craters and lava pillars. Return to your hotel for an evening at your leisure.

(B,L)Overnight: Mytvatn area

This morning you leave Mytvatn and travel east. Your first stop will be Hverir, a large geothermal ment. Soak in the view as you journey up the white field of bubbling mud pools, hissing fumaroles, and slopes. Upon arrival enter the man-made ice tunnel sticky red soil. You'll soon realize why Iceland is and your guide will lead you deep into the blue heart named the Land of Fire and Ice. It's also the closest you'll ever get to Mars on Earth! Journey onto Dettisics of glacier knowledge and admire the different foss Waterfall, the most powerful waterfall in Europe, shades of blue. 


