
Colorado's Rails and Rockies

Upon arrival, visit the Overnight: Colorado Springs cliff dwellings inhabited by Anasazi, known as the Ancient Ones, nearly 4,000 years ago. This is the nation's largest archeological preserve with 4,000 sights including 600 cliff dwellings. Your travels continue eastward, with a comfort stop and time for lunch on your own before visiting the Great Sand Dunes National Park, the tallest dunes in North America. A sandbox of epic proportion, the entire dune field encompasses 30 square miles with the tallest dune towers 750 feet high. 
